11th International Symposium on Safety Science and Technology (11th ISSST) will be held in Shanghai, China, August 6–9, 2018. The Symposium is a continuation of the previous ten international symposia held in Beijing (1998 and 2000), Tai'an (2002), Shanghai (2004), Changsha (2006), Beijing (2008), Hangzhou (2010), Nanjing (2012), Beijing(2014) and Kunming (2016) respectively. The aim of the Symposium is still to provide an up-to-date discussion in the field of safety science and technology. Both full papers and extended abstracts are welcome to be submitted. All accepted papers or extended abstracts will be included in the proceedings (without ISBN) to be distributed at the symposium. Outstanding papers will be recommended to SCI journals.

Papers or extended abstracts will cover fundamental aspects, technical approaches and/or the related areas as follows:

- Safety system and engineering
- > Prevention of fire, explosion, dust and ventilation

- Public safety

Instructions for extended abstracts or

papers preparation

All those interested in presenting a contribution are invited to submit a proposed Title, Author(s) Name, Institution(with mailing address and e-mail address) and a 500–1000 words abstract that may include the purpose, results, significance of the contribution and comparison with the previous state of art to the secretariat.

The full papers should include a Title with the Name(s) of the Author(s) and Affiliation(s) of Author(s) and an Abstract of 150–200 words followed by sections including an introduction, the main body of text, conclusions, acknowledgements, and references. Papers are limited to 14 pages. Figures and tables should be embedded and not supplied separately.

Files should be in MS Word format only and should be formatted for direct printing, following the instructions provided on website. To avoid unnecessary errors you are strongly advised to use the "spellchecker" function of MS Word.

Submission of abstracts and papers

Full papers or extended abstracts should be submitted through website NO LATER THAN MAY 10, which is a deadline for full paper submission to be included into the printed Proceedings and CDs so as to distribute at the symposium. The author is welcome to state his preference for oral or poster session.

Exhibition

Limited exhibition space in the lobby of the symposium hall is provided for products, equipment and advertising material relevant to the topics of the symposium.
