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#### Introduction

2014 International Symposium on Safety Science and Technology (2014 ISSST) will be held at Beijing Xijiao Hotel, in Beijing, China, November 4–6, 2014. The Symposium is a continuation of the previous eight international symposia held in Beijing (1998 and 2000), Tai'an (2002), Shanghai (2004), Changsha (2006), Beijing (2008), Hangzhou (2010) and Nanjing (2012) respectively. The aim of the Symposium is still to provide an up-to-date discussion in the field of safety science and technology.

#### **Conference Language**

#### **Timing of Presentations**


Each paper will be allotted 20 minutes (including introduction and question-and-answer period), except where noted.
